TOURING IDEAS -

Day 1: Depart U.S. for Scotland

Depart U.S. on your overnight flight to Glasgow.

Day 2: Glasgow City Tour

Arrive in Glasgow Airport, pick up your car and drive to your hotel, centrally located near Sauchiehall Street, Glasgow's main pedestrianized shopping thoroughfare. You may like to head out to explore the city or rest after your journey.

Day 3: Loch Lomond & Glen Coe

Today drive along the banks of Loch Lomond and into the Highlands. There are plenty of places to stop and admire the scenery. You may choose to travel to the Georgian town of Inveraray and the seaside town of Oban. Or drive across Rannoch Moor and through the magnificent Glen Coe to Loch Linnhe and Ballachulish.

Day 4: The Great Glen & Loch Ness

Drive to Fort Augustus where you may like to take a sightseeing cruise on Loch Ness. Then and travel beside Loch Ness for lovely views of the lake and hills. Your route will take you through Inverness, capital city of the Highlands, and close to Culloden Moor. If you wish, you can drive through the Spey Valley, famous for all the whisky distilleries located there.

Day 5: Royal Deeside

Explore the lovely valley of the River Dee, favored by Queen Victoria and most of the Royal Family. Stop in the attractive town of Ballater where many shops show a royal warrant, indicating patronage by the Royal Family. You may like to explore some of the great castles in the region, especially the fairytale Crathes Castle. Aberdeen is a short distance from your hotel.

Day 6: East Coast

Travel south to Edinburgh, either through Dundee, St. Andrews, the "Home of Golf" and the lovely little fishing villages of the Kingdom of Fife. You may prefer to head inland to visit Scone Palace and the city of Perth. You could travel to Stirling to visit the Wallace Monument or the massive Stirling Castle. Then take the motorway to Edinburgh.



Day 7: Edinburgh Castle & City Tour

Enjoy a full day in Edinburgh. Explore the "New Town", the 200-year-old Georgian region with lovely houses, spacious squares and alleyways full of shops and bars. See the Royal Mile as it stretches from the Palace of Holyroodhouse to Edinburgh Castle, which sits high on a volcanic plug. Views from the Castle are great and a tour will give you a great overview of the city's and the country's history. Use your voucher for your prepaid open-top bus tour around Edinburgh. You may choose from a number of routes to discover Edinburgh's main attractions, travel on a vintage bus or take a route to Leith to see the Royal Yacht "Britannia."

Day 8: Depart for Home

Drop your rental car or minibus at Edinburgh Airport in good time to check in for your flight. If you wish to extend your vacation, we can book additional nights in Edinburgh for you. (For more detailed itinerary suggestions, see Scottish Dream coach tour on pages 56/57.)
